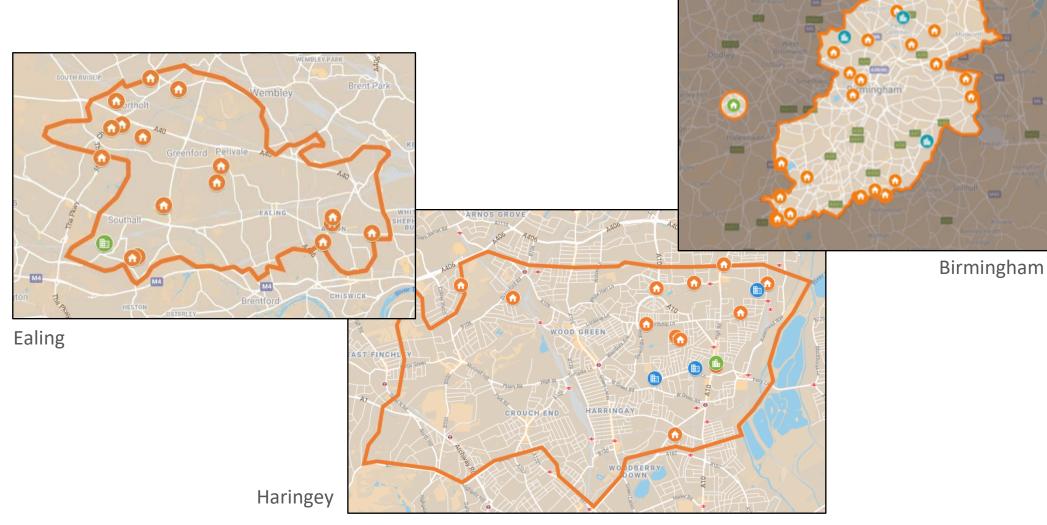




What do we actually do?

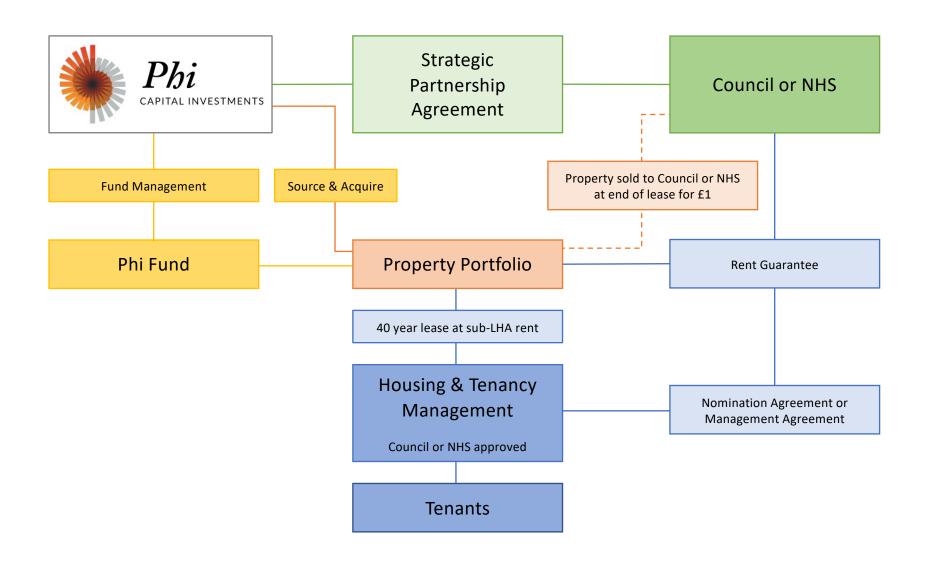

FAQs

- Where do you make your money?
- What is it going to cost us?
- Why wouldn't we just do this ourselves?
- Are you a REIT?
- Aren't inflation-linked leases bad?
- How can you make it work at sub-LHA rents and sell the property for £1 at the end?
- Isn't this just too good to be true?

In Summary...

- "Additionality" not a replacement...
 ... housing stock, expertise, control, options, discharge of duties
- Housing protected against RTB (and replace stock lost to RTB)
- Reversion of housing to Council for £1 at the end of the term
- Flexibility over rental income; control over tenure, and rent setting
- More visibility and influence over new developments (especially PD schemes)
- Ability to target meeting bespoke needs, specific or general
- Full control over quality of housing management services
- Flexible solutions from 1 unit of accommodation to 101 units of accommodation
